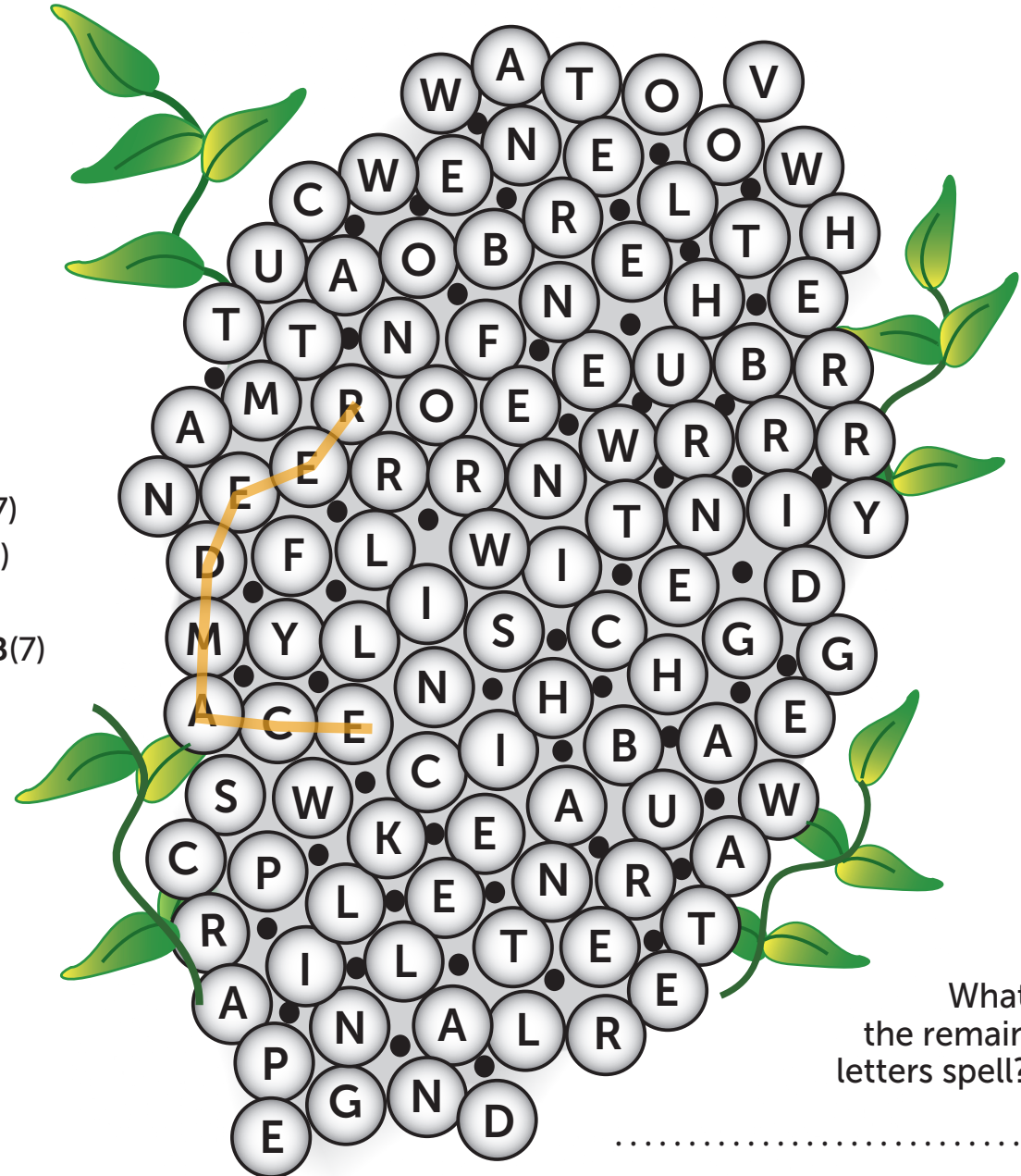


WATERY WORD PUZZLE
