

## Clarification Questions and Answers for Acle Footpath Tender 2024:

**Q - Are the recycled plastic edging board revetments intended to be used as well as the timber edging boards, or are they in the tender so you can decide which material to use once you've seen the prices?**

A – Decide which material to use once we have seen the prices.

**Q - Is there anywhere along the path suitable to have material delivered to by an 8-wheeler lorry? i.e. lay-bys that will be closed off by Public Highways. We'll drive by ourselves, but I wondered if you've already considered this, and if so, whether the relevant consents have been applied for. If not, can you let me know if we need to include applications for consent for TM and lay-by closures as part of the tender.**


A - There is a layby adjacent to the path which we have contacted the council about using for storage.

**Q – What areas do you have in mind for storage?**

A – There is a layby adjacent to the path which ends close to an entrance to the path.

**Q – How do the 2 bridges on the path affect the route of the construction vehicles?**

A – The bridges do not enclose any section of the path, there is at least one opening to each section which can be used as access for construction vehicles.

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
